Bird Group Itinerary 2008/2009

April 13, 2008	Chaguaramas Forest birding along roads and trails on the Northwestern peninsula.
May 10/11, 2008 (Saturday/Sunday)	Grande Riviere Overnight stay at Grande Riviere village on Trinidad's North coast. The Pawi (Trinidad Piping-Guan) is regularly seen in this area.
June 15, 2008	Mt. St. Benedict Birding along trails on the southern slopes of the Northern Range. Forest birds and raptors.
July 12, 2008 (Saturday)	Chaguaramas- Night Birding Beginning late afternoon and continuing into the evening. Targets are nightjars, potoos and owls.
August 17, 2008	Paramin Tanagers, honeycreepers and other forest birds, as well as several raptors, are usually seen in this area.
September 14, 2008	Cacandee Wetland birding. Several Northern migrants may be seen, as well as resident species.
October 3, 2008	Orange Valley Excellent views of waders on the mudflats along the west coast.
November 16, 2008	Arima/Blanchisseuse Road High-altitude forest birding in the Northern range.
January 11, 2009	Moruga Swamp forest habitat on Trinidad's South coast.
February 15, 2009	Nariva A visit to the Nariva protected area, as well as Kernaham and Manzanilla.
March 15, 2009	Brasso Seco Birding along roads and trails around Brasso Seco, a secluded village off the Arima-Blanchisseuse Road. An overnight stay may be possible.
